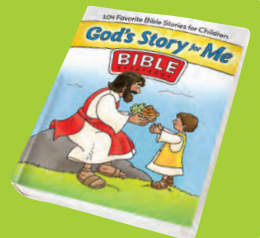

We all want our kids to grow in their understanding of God and His love. But it often seems like an overwhelming task!

Pass it on!

Never forget that you *are* teaching your kids every minute! Planned teaching times have far less impact on young children than what they see and hear from us as we live our lives! Here are a few simple ways to pass on your faith in the midst of busy moments:

- **Play!** As you ride or walk, play “See what God made.” Look for things of one color (blue, green, etc.) or one shape (round, square, etc.). After you’ve found several, thank God for them!
- **Sing!** As you drive, give baths or pick up toys, sing simple songs that remind yourselves of God’s love. (You can get a CD of this year’s new songs from your child’s teacher!)

Night Walk

Look on the Internet or check out a book to find information about space. Talk to your child about the sun, moon and stars. Pack hot chocolate and a snack. Then take your family on a night walk. Stop and have hot chocolate and snacks while looking at the moon and stars.



You are your child’s most powerful teacher. Ask God to help you use that power wisely!

Bible Story

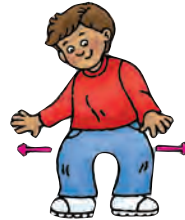
Genesis 1:1-19

Invite your child to do the illustrated motions with you. **For older children:** How many stars can you count? How many clouds?

God made leafy **trees** that grow very tall.

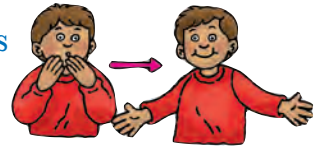


He made flowers and **plants** that help feed us all.
